Sturdy Health Cancer & Specialty Care Building



Sturdy Health recently celebrated the groundbreaking for the new Sturdy Health Cancer & Specialty Care Medical Office Building.

The construction is expected to take multiple years and the three-story building will span more than 60,000 square feet. The project represents a \$50 million investment and aligns with Sturdy Health’s strategic master space plan initiative to expand care access, as well as transform its facilities and experience.

“For over 110 years, Sturdy Health has dedicated itself to providing exceptional care, exceptionally close to those we serve,” said Aimee Brewer, CEO and president of Sturdy Health. “As we look to continue this legacy, we envisioned our next bold steps forward in fortifying a health system that would continue providing the quality of healthcare our community deserves in the years ahead.”

Several specialty services will be housed at the new center, including cardiology, gastrointestinal, general and breast surgery, oncology, pain management, and urology. Also, the space will unite the infusion center currently located in Sturdy Memorial Hospital to offer a more comprehensive care experience for oncology patients.

“It’s for our patients that we dreamt of a beautiful, hope-filled space where they could receive multidisciplinary, integrated, and seamless cancer care under one roof,” said Dr. Asma Latif, director of breast oncology at Sturdy Health. “This new building will strengthen our cancer care in every way, uniting not only our outpatient practice and infusion program but a breadth of support services and specialties as well. While we’re thrilled to offer this comprehensive care to our patients, we’ll continue to pride ourselves in maintaining that personal touch.”

Consigli Construction Co., based in Milford, Mass., is leading the project’s construction. Boston-based Redgate will serve as the owner’s representative and lead the planning, permitting, and overall project delivery strategy. Also collaborating on the project is NBBJ, an architecture firm also based in Boston.

“The significance of this transformative project for Sturdy Health, the city of Attleboro, and the community is one that we are extremely proud to be a part of,” said Anthony Consigli, CEO of Consigli Construction. “Together, we are constructing more than a facility; we are creating a space that fosters compassionate care for a stronger, healthier community.”

Sturdy Health looks forward to welcoming patients into this state-of-the-art space in 2025.

In April of 2023, Sturdy Memorial Hospital celebrated 110 years of caring for the people of Southeastern Massachusetts and Rhode Island. We marked this momentous milestone by beginning an exciting new chapter in the life of our health system. We also took a significant first step in a multi-year transformative journey that will make our brand easier to identify, expand, and enhance the services we offer, upgrade our facilities, and greatly improve the experience we provide to our patients and our physicians, providers, and team members.

To mark this milestone, we announced that we were formally evolving our name from Sturdy Memorial Hospital to Sturdy Health.

Throughout the remainder of 2023, we united Sturdy Memorial Hospital, our Sturdy Memorial Foundation, and Sturdy Memorial Associates under one unifying Sturdy Health brand umbrella. By making this change, we can make it clear that we are an integrated healthcare system that offers hospital-based care, emergency and urgent care, primary care, and a wide range of specialty care at 26 locations across the region.

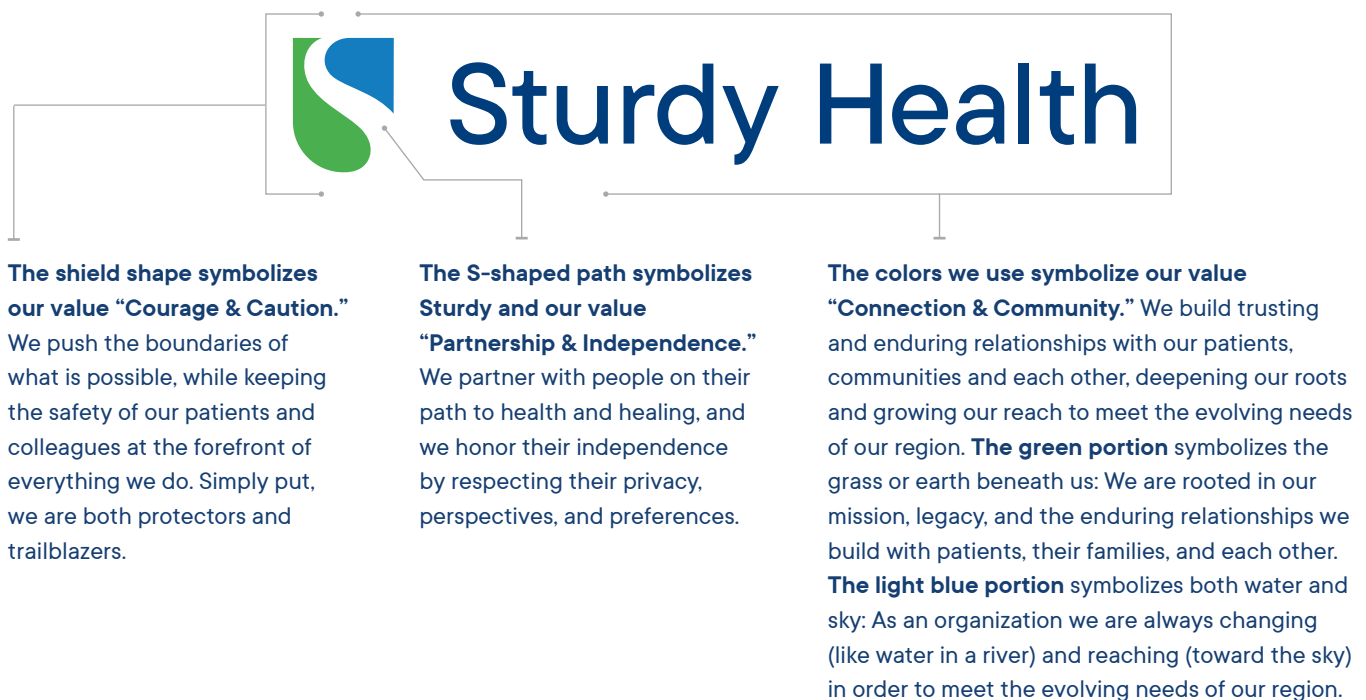
